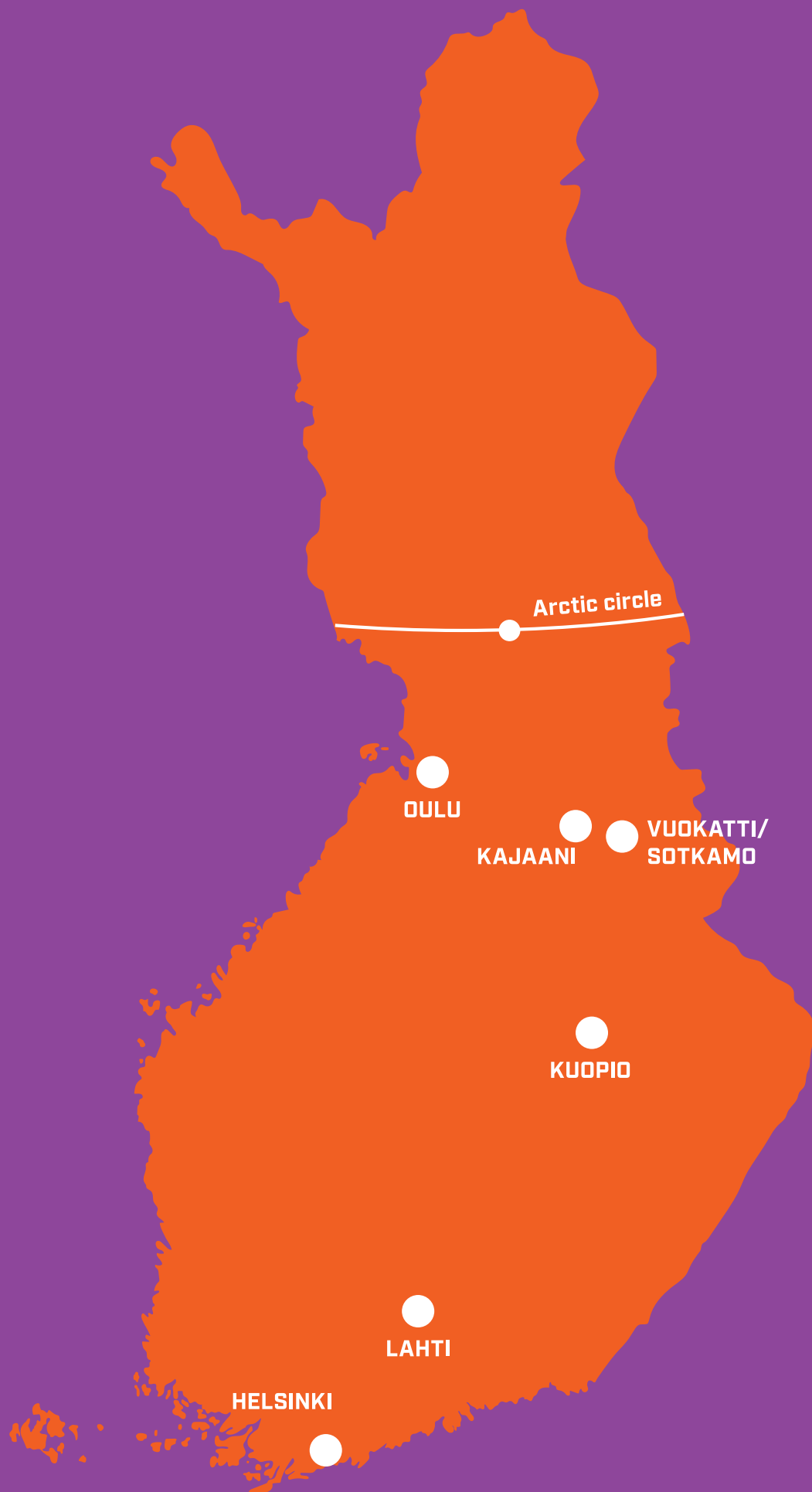

## 5 **FINANCIAL ASPECTS**

### 5.1. Participation fee

Finland is one of the most expensive countries in Europe and the cost of living is high. Therefore, the participation fee is set at 120 euros / person / day and it needs to be paid in two instalments (first instalment of 50% of the participation fee by 18.10.2021 and payment of the remaining 50% by 10.3.2022). The participation fee covers the costs incurred by the participants for accommodation, food and transport. We have received questions asking if it's possible to make payments earlier and we're happy to accommodate your request. Please let our Secretary General (marita.kaipainen@eyof2022.fi) know if you wish to pay your participation fees before the deadlines above! Note that in that case we also need to know your Final Entries by Number earlier.

### 5.2. Deposit

Each NOC must also pay a deposit of 50 EUR/person. The deposit will be collected in case of any damage caused to a room, for cancellation penalties or bank charges. The deposit for the Boys' Ice Hockey teams will be included in the final payment for December and will be returned to NOCs in full by end of April 2022 along with the March 2022 deposits if there are no charges to be collected. Please note that it is the final number of entries that are financially binding for the NOCs.

The ceiling for the above said deposit is 3000 per NOC, and includes cover for both the December Ice Hockey tournament and the other competitions scheduled for March 2022.

## 6 **IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS FORMALITIES**

Finland is part of the European Union and one of the Schengen states. A valid national passport or other equivalent official document that satisfactorily establishes a person's identity and nationality is needed when entering into Finland. It must be valid for at least ninety days after the intended date of departure from the Schengen area. In addition, the passport or other travel document must be less than ten years old.

If a person is not a citizen of Finland or another European Economic Area (EEA) country, they may also need a visa. The European countries whose citizens need a visa when entering Finland are Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Kosovo, Turkey and Russia. For a short stay (up to 90 days in the Schengen area) a visa is not needed for UK citizens.

The citizens of countries that need a visa to enter Finland must pay the cost of acquiring the visa themselves. You should submit your visa application at Embassy of Finland or a visa centre no later than 15 days before travel. The application can be submitted at the earliest six months before the intended visit. In case Finland is represented in the country by another Schengen state, the processing time is usually longer. If an invitation letter for your visa is needed, please contact the NOC services and we will help you.

## 6.1. Pharmaceutical products

Outside EU: Pharmaceutical products used at international sports events (Article 60 of the Duty Relief Regulation)

Pharmaceutical products for human medical use by persons coming from third countries to participate in international sports events organised in the customs territory of the EU, shall, within the limits necessary to meet their requirements throughout their stay in that territory, be admitted free of import duties. No VAT is collected on the import of goods that are free of import duties based on Article 60 of the Duty Relief Regulation.

## 8 DELEGATION REGISTRATION PROCESS

The Registration and Accreditation system can be found at <https://ras.eurolympic.org/>. The system is open for the teams and the login details have been provided for each NOC. A bulk data import sheet can be downloaded from the system, along with other important documents and manuals.

The Organizing Committee will implement a policy regarding the collection and handling of personal data of the registered participants in compliance with national and EU GDPR rules and regulations. Therefore, also the Entry and Eligibility Conditions Form must be duly completed, signed and submitted by each NOC to the Organizing Committee. The form must be submitted before the Short List submission can be activated.

The main Accreditation Centre will be in the Athletes' Village at Vuokatti Sport, and there will be Sub-Accreditation centres at the EOC Family hotel and for the Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined teams in their hotel in Lahti.

## 8.2. Working passes

There are two types of working passes available in Vuokatti: one-off payment of 100 € for accreditation and transportation in the event shuttle bus, or 120 € per day including all the same services as athletes and accommodation with or near the delegation. We try to accommodate the working pass holders near their teams, but please be aware that this might not be possible every time.

The quota is 10 % of the NOC delegation size.

Prices for working passes in Lahti will be communicated in September.

# 8 ACCOMMODATION

The Athletes' Village is located at Vuokatti Sport and all the accommodation venues will be within walking distance from the Athletes' Village. Regardless of this, the shuttle bus will serve all accommodation, Athletes' Village and venues. The whole complex is located at the heart of Vuokatti, where the teams can enjoy versatile possibilities for supplementary training, recreation and relaxation. In the Athletes' Village there will be adequate security and access control.

Accommodation in Vuokatti ranges from budget rooms to high-standard apartments and hotel rooms. Hotel ratings vary mostly between 3-4 star. However, please note that there are no official hotel ratings in Finland, and they are based on hotel management's evaluation. The planned number of beds per room is 2-3, and all the beds are for single use. The ratio of WC/shower per accommodated person will not exceed 4 persons per WC/shower.

There are several meeting rooms available ranging from small rooms to auditoriums for larger group meetings and conferences. There is an auditorium with a capacity of 110-160 persons in the centre of the Athletes Village, that can be used for e.g. Chef de Mission meetings. There are also several smaller meeting rooms with a capacity of between 16-50 persons.

All the halls, premises, training venues and catering services are within walking distance of the accommodation. Even the supermarket is only a 15 min walk away. Vuokatti offers excellent opportunities for supplementary training, such as gym, gymnastics, ball and racquet games, cross-country skiing and ice or water sports.

Teams competing in Lahti will be accommodated in Pajulahti Sports Institute/Olympic Training Centre. The planned number of beds per room is 2-4, and all the beds are for single use. The ratio of WC/shower per accommodated person will not exceed 4 persons per WC/shower. Distance to the stadium is approximately 30-35 minutes by car. ## 10 TRANSPORT TO AND FROM **KAJAANI AND VUOKATTI**

Finland is easy to reach. The main gateway is Helsinki-Vantaa international airport. Even though Finland is a large and sparsely populated country, getting from point A to B is no hassle. Transport networks by air, rail, road and water are comprehensive and reliable.

Kajaani is the official port of entry so the entry fee includes transportation organized by the organising committee from Kajaani airport or railway station to Vuokatti. For the Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined team, official port of entry is Helsinki-Vantaa Airport. Transportation from Helsinki-Vantaa airport to Lahti / accommodation will be organised by the organising committee.

### **Air**

Kajaani Airport is the nearest Northern European transit airport connecting Vuokatti to all major destinations in Europe. Kajaani Airport is located 45 km away from Vuokatti and there is a bus connection from the airport to the resort. Flights from Helsinki to Kajaani take from 1 hour to 1 hour 20 min. The transport time from Kajaani international airport to the centre of Vuokatti is approximately 40 minutes by bus. In addition to Kajaani airport, there are also several flight connections to Oulu and Kuopio, both of which are located only about a 2-hour drive from Vuokatti.

To get a big amount of baggage to Vuokatti on time, most of it will be transported Helsinki – Kajaani – Helsinki by road. This is to minimize the risk that the baggage won't fit in the planes and also to secure that the baggage will arrive to the venue or the connecting flights on time.

The global pandemic made air travel rearrangements necessary and the regular flights currently serving Kajaani are not sufficient to serve our event. Therefore we ask all teams kindly send their preliminary flight plans (to Helsinki Vantaa airport or if you're flying charter) to [nocservices@eyof2022.fi](mailto:nocservices@eyof2022.fi) by 30.9.2021 (use the form sent together with this Team Info). Please include the team's point of origin and likely flight dates and times, as well as other travel plans to Kajaani. Please note that there might not be any flights available to reserve between Helsinki and Kajaani at the moment, but the OC will negotiate additional flights. Information for delegations arriving in December will be communicated separately.



### **Sea**

Finland can be reached also by sea. There are regular ferry connections from Germany, Estonia and Sweden to Helsinki or Turku.



### **Rail**

Finnish trains are spacious, comfortable and clean. The rail network stretches all over the country from Helsinki to Lapland. Four to five trains arrive daily to Kajaani from Helsinki via Kuopio or Oulu, with the journey taking 6–10 hours depending on the train. There are also daily trains for example to Rovaniemi and Oulu. Finnish rail traffic is controlled by one company and timetables and prices can be found on [www.vr.fi/en](http://www.vr.fi/en).



### **Road**

Finland has right-handed traffic with a polite and stress-free driving culture. There's a good network of petrol stations close to each other. Finland's coach route network is one of the most comprehensive in Europe covering more than 90 per cent of public roads. There are several daily connections by bus from major cities in Finland to Kajaani and Sotkamo. ## 11 TRANSPORT DURING THE COMPETITION WEEK

The Athletes' Village and sport venues are within walking distance, except for Ice Hockey which is held in Kajaani as well as Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined which are organised in Lahti. A shuttle bus service will be organized to facilitate the transportation of all participants between the sport venues and the Athletes' Village in Vuokatti and Kajaani. There will not be a bus service between Vuokatti and Lahti.

There will be bus transfer service between Kajaani and Vuokatti for Ice Hockey teams and other accredited groups. There will not be dedicated busses for each Ice Hockey team 24/7 but they will be transported to and from arenas according to the training / game schedules or if they want to go and see other games. Transportation Mall will be in the Athletes' Village.

For the Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined teams, there will be bus transportation between the accommodation and the stadium.

For athletes competing and training in Kajaani, lunch/ dinner will be served in Kajaani University of Applied Sciences (700 m away from the venue) whenever it is not possible to have meals in the Vuokatti event restaurant.

For the Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined team, breakfast will be served in their hotel. Lunch and Dinner will be served in the hotel or at the stadium depending on the daily training / competition schedule.

## 13 MEDICAL SERVICES AND COVID-19

During the competitions, there will be first aid service at all sport venues and a doctor in Athletes' Village providing primary medical care [will be defined more precisely later] for the accredited people every day. In each venue (Vuokatti, Kajaani and Lahti) there will be signposted first aid station. Services are available daily during training and competition hours.

The nearest health clinic to Vuokatti during daytime is in Sotkamo (6km from the Athletes' Village). In case of emergency when the health clinics are closed, there is a possibility to visit a 24-hour emergency clinic at Kainuu Central Hospital in Kajaani (40 km from the Athletes' Village). At Kainuu Central Hospital in Kajaani, all the essential medical departments can be found. In more severe medical situations, the transport to the Oulu University Hospital will be organized.

A pharmacy is located about 3 km away from the Athletes' Village, in the centre of Vuokatti. Detailed information regarding the import of medicines & medical devices and medical doctors' registration will be communicated with the next info package.

## 13.1. Covid-19

The LOC will take every step to guarantee the safety of the participants and will follow any Covid-19 rules and recommendations laid out by the local and national health authorities. More information will follow closer to the event.

## 13.2. EOC Anti-Doping Rules

The event will be conducted under the WADA approved EOC Anti-Doping Rules managed on behalf of the EOC by the International Testing Agency (ITA), who will operate in junction with the Finnish Antidoping Agency FINADA.

Finland's Antidoping Code is compliant with the 2021 WADA Code and is WADA approved. The Finnish Government and the NOC of Finland fully comply with the World Anti-Doping Code and WADA regulations. The Finnish Antidoping Agency (FINADA) is Finland's National Anti-Doping Organization. FINADA is responsible for doping control activities at the national level in Finland and NOC Finland and FINADA are Code Signatories in the event.

Both urine and blood tests will be carried in compliance with the EOC Anti-Doping Rules.

## 14 SAFETY AND SECURITY

FINLAND IS ONE OF THE SAFEST COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD.

Anyone participating in the EYOF, from the spectators to the athletes, can rest assured that every possible measure has been taken to guarantee their comfort and safety. EYOF 2022 Security Management Group consists of the representatives of the local police, fire department, security office and Finnish Border Guard and they will ensure that all the appropriate and necessary security measures are taken by the competent authorities of Finland, the region and the municipality in order to guarantee a safe and peaceful staging of the EYOF.

The emergency number is 112. No area code is necessary.

Please see your country's Foreign Affairs for more information about Finland and necessary travel arrangements.

The Organizing Committee will take out general liability insurance for all athletes and officials for the duration of their stay in Finland, which covers all claims for loss, injury, repatriation, damage to goods and individuals, including temporary or permanent disability or death, arising from the holding of the EYOF 2022. The Organising Committee will also cover medical costs for all accredited persons from the official arrival day till the official departure day (permanent disability, consequential damage, cost of medical treatment). However, all NOCs are strongly advised to provide an adequate insurance (travel insurance) policy for the members of their delegations.

## 15 IT & TECHNOLOGY

### 15.1. Wi-Fi & Phone usage

Free wi-fi is provided at the accommodation and the sports venues.

A selection of pre-paid Finnish SIM cards will be available from the NOC Services Office.

### 15.2. App & Website

An app for the games is being developed and will be ready for use in December. The app is part of our aim to protect the environment by minimizing the use of paper. The event website can be found at <https://eyof2022.fi/>. Results and information will be posted in both the app and the website.

### 15.3. Radio equipment and frequencies

The Finnish Traffic and Communications Agency (TRAFICOM) controls the use of radio frequencies in Finland and ensures that a sufficient number of frequencies are equally available in order to ensure that all users are able to operate in cooperative and legal manner.



**Licence-exempted equipment**

Equipment using collective frequencies can be used without a radio licence from TRAFICOM. However, users should be aware that there might be several users on these frequencies and interference may occur. Please see TRAFICOMs Regulation 15 on collective frequencies for licence-exempt radio transmitters (LA, CB, PR 27, RHA68, PMR 446 (analog and digital phones), etc.) and their use:

**Radio licences**

The use of certain radio equipment (private mobile radio (PMR), wireless cameras, radio microphones that does not meet licence-free conditions, etc.) requires a radio licence from TRAFICOM. TRAFICOM assigns the frequencies to be used in the licence and it is prohibited to use any other frequencies than those mentioned in the licence.

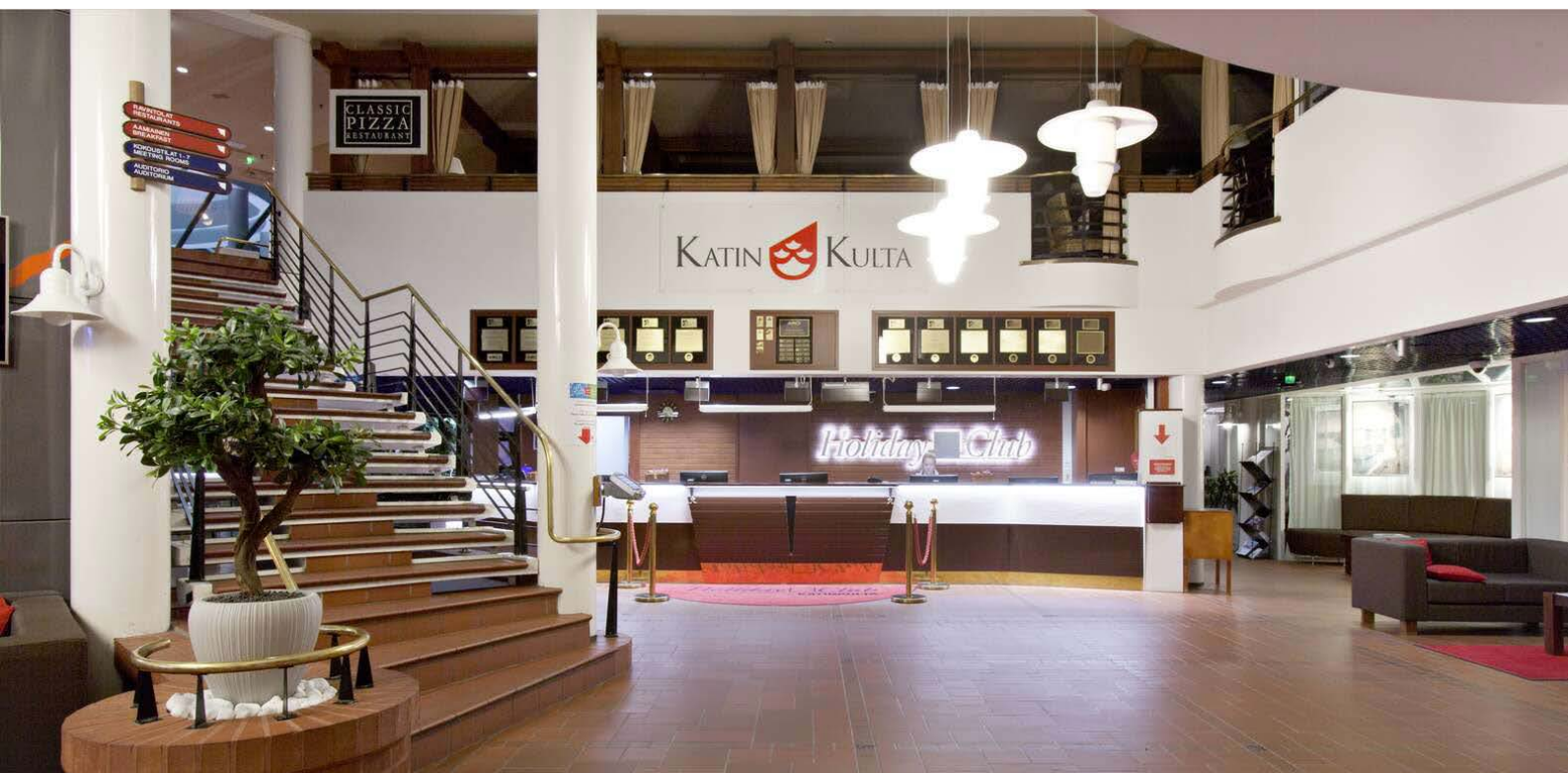

### 20.2. Media Centres and Mixed Zones

The sports events will be televised and/or streamed, and the stream will also be available at the Main press centre. The results service and athletes' interviews will be available for the media. Hard copies of comments and results will also be available upon request – one of the goals of the event is to stay as environmentally friendly as possible and avoid any unnecessary printing.

There will be «Mixed Zones» at all competition venues, where members of the media can mix with competitors and conduct interviews after the competitions. Access of the media representatives to the mixed zones will be ensured.

## 22 VENUES

### 22.1. Vuokatti Sport Institute (Cross Country Skiing, Biathlon)

Vuokatti Sport Institute is in the heart of the ski tracks' starting point, which makes it easy to change trails and enjoy the variety of routes in the region. There is a wide network of ski tracks. The first tracks are open for training already in October and in mid-winter there are more than 150 km of well-groomed tracks. Approximately 32 km of the trail network is illuminated. Natural snow arrives in November-December, and the season continues until April. Due to the diverse landscape, Vuokatti provides cross country skiing facilities for top athletes as well as fitness enthusiasts. Every year, the ski trail networks serve numerous cross country skiing events, including both national and international FIS standard competitions. The waxing cabinets are located next to the competition tracks.

### 22.2. Vuokatti Ski Resort (Alpine Ski, Snowboarding)

Vuokatti Ski Resort is located 2 kilometres from the Athletes' Village (by car) and walking distance is only 300m-1km. There are 13 slopes, including Olympic standard Big Air, SuperPipe and SlopeStyle, as well as FIS homologated OlympiaKatti slope. SuperPipe and SlopeStyle slopes have been in use since 2014, and the Finnish National Snowboarding Championships have already been organised there. Vuokatti Ski Resort has two Rental Office stations; northern and western. Both Rental Offices contain a ticket office, rental shop, sport shop, restaurant - and cafeteria services. All the EYOF competitions will be organised near the northern service station. The main building in the north contains facilities for race management, service buildings, as well as parking areas for athletes, media and spectators. The waxing cabinets are located next to the competition tracks.

### 22.3. Vuokatti Arena (Short Track, Figure Skating)

The new Vuokatti Arena is located in the heart of the Athletes' Village. This investment project includes building two new Olympic size 30x60 m ice rinks in Vuokatti. The venue has four locker rooms including showers, one referee locker room, other service facilities and a cafeteria. There are also two locker rooms next to the ice hall, which are also available for use by the EYOF. The ice hall has seats for 400 spectators and a parking space for 250 cars.

## 22.4. Kajaani Ice Halls (Ice Hockey)

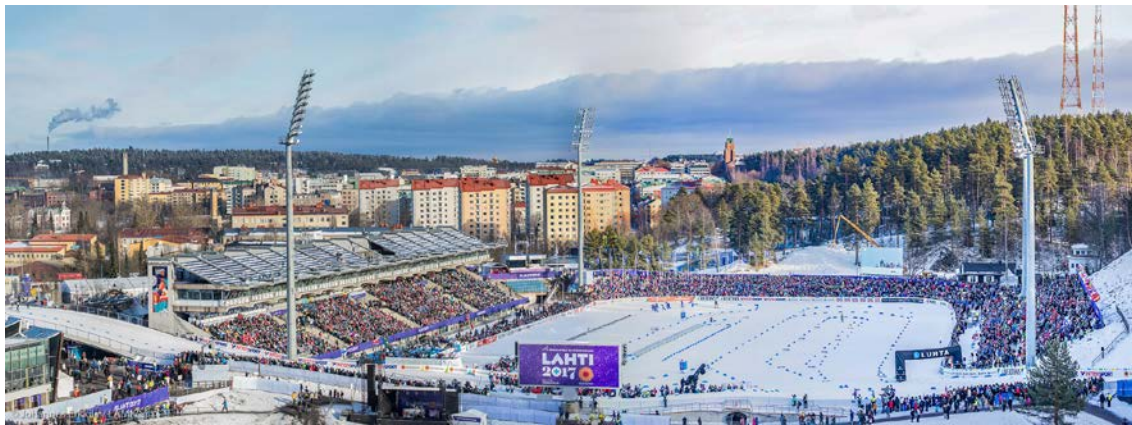
Kajaani Ice Halls are located in the Vimpeli Valley's Sport Centre in Kajaani. The size of the competition rink is 29 x 60 m, and it meets the international standards to host ice hockey. The ice hall is the home venue of Kajaanin Hokki, an Ice Hockey team that plays in the 2nd Division of the Finnish Ice Hockey League. Size of the rinks are at competition arena 29 x 60 m and at the training arena 26 x 56 m. Seating capacity in the competition arena is 1200 and in the training arena there are 250 standing places. Locker rooms: competition arena 5, training arena 4.



## 22.5. Lahti Sports Center (Nordic Combined, Ski Jumping)

Internationally known Lahti Sports Centre is the heart of the ski games. At the sports centre are located the ski jump towers, restaurant Voitto, ice hockey arena, ski museum, outdoor swimming pool and much more. During the wintertime there are ski trails on the area and during the summertime outdoor hiking trails. Every year Lahti hosts FIS World Cup in Cross Country, Nordic Combined and Ski Jumping.

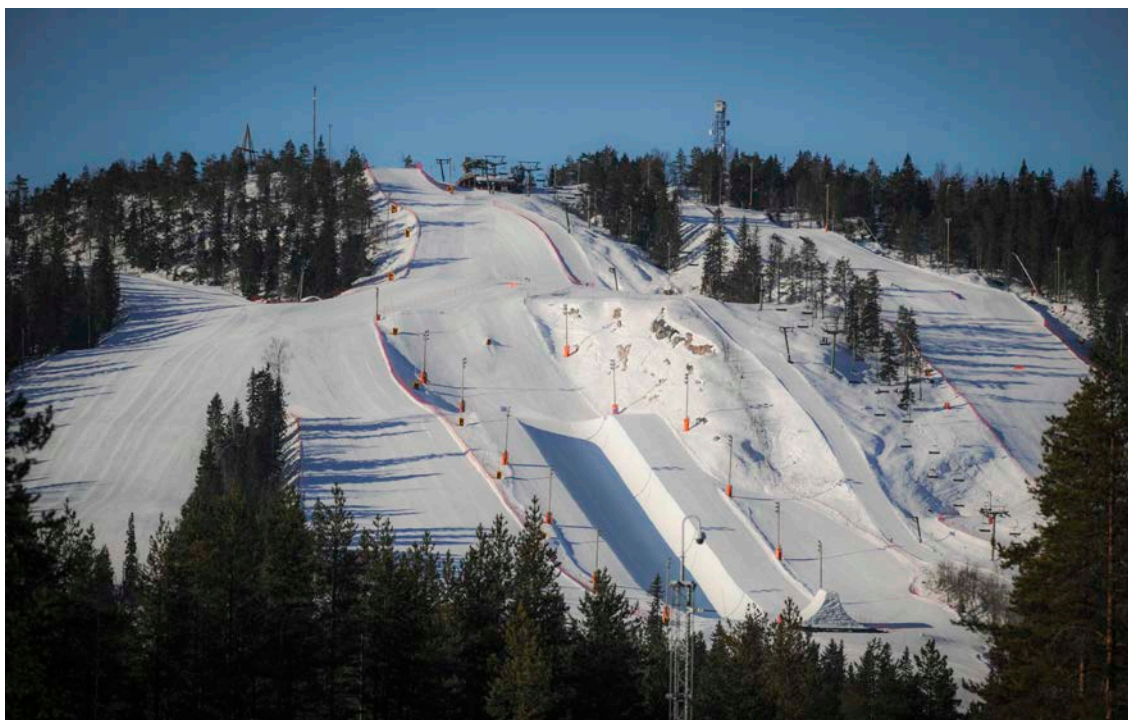
